The tabernacle prayer by Margaret Cornell

Nothing could be more important than meeting with the Lord in the holy of Holies or as it is sometimes called the secret place.

In the Song of Solomon 2. 14(passion translation) "let me see your radiant face and hear your sweet voice. How beautiful your eyes of worship and lovely your voice in prayer"

Locating myself in the Holy Place, or the secret place, in the past has been by praying in the spirit and singing in the spirit, or approaching Him through music such as 'The sea of Galilee 'Now I see that the tabernacle could provide another answer.

We enter into the tabernacle using our imagination

We come through the GATE of the tabernacle ...the door ...who of course is Jesus himself, and we are immediately faced with the brazen altar or the cross, the place where we received Jesus into our lives

This is what I said. But .I suggest you make your own version and write it down as I did and read it and pray until you get the ideas into your system

"I want to thank you Lord for all I have received because of your cross. Thank you Lord for the complete forgiveness and that you have washed all my sins away, not just covered them.

You have given me your righteousness, and I am sanctified, made Holy and I am your beloved child. Thank you that on the cross you bore the curse for me of sickness poverty sin and death.

I died with you on the cross and I rose with you to be seated in heavenly places far above all principality and power and wicked spirits. You have

seated me at the right hand of the father and given me your authority to defeat my enemies. They are under my feet

Thank you for the blood of the cross, that precious blood that wrought for me full salvation, nothing missing. Thank you that the blood of your cross has delivered me from the power of darkness and brought me into your marvellous light

I love you Lord for all you've done on the cross for me, all that was accomplished by your wonderful sacrifice, and I thank you for that amazing, good work that you began in me which You will complete on the day of Christ.

Today I offer myself to you upon this altar as a living sacrifice so that I might bless you and glorify you in all I do and all I am

I come to the LAVER that was made with the mirrors of the Israelite women. And as I hold up the mirror of your word, I find my new identity and my mind is renewed.

Thank you Lord that you daily wash me with your word and that your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path .Thank you Lord that you inspire me with faith as I receive Rhema from your word

I enter the HOLY PLACE and I come to the lampstand and remember that you are the light of the worldthank you that your light lives in me and is able to shine out to every person in my worldhelp me never to dim that life through sin and negativity , help me to keep that light burning brightly.

Thank you for your Holy Spirit and for all He does for me. I honour your Holy Spirit and give Him free reign in my life.

Lord, I worship you, forgive me for neglecting the gift of tongues.

Thank you Lord that your Holy Spirit brings me wisdom and understanding, counsel and might, and the fear of the Lord

Thank you Lord your Holy Spirit anoints me and blesses me with your Holy presence. Thank you, Lord, that because you have filled me with your Holy Spirit you have made me into your tabernacle, your dwelling place.

Thank you, Lord, for the beautiful fruit that I have it within me because of your Holy Spirit. I have love, Joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. I thank you Lord that you give me words of knowledge, words of wisdom ,tongues, interpretation of tongues, gifts of healing, and prophecy all of which bring me strength to live my life with your revelations

Thank you Lord that your Holy Spirit quickens my physical body and gives me the energy to accomplish all I need to do today Help me lord to keep this tabernacle ,this precious house ,clean pure and holy

I come to the TABLE OF SHEWBREAD that is symbolic of your covenant faithfulness to Israel. I am reminded that you are the bread of life and that you meet my needs according to all your riches in glory by Christ Jesus. As I see this bread, I remember that you said that he who eats the true bread of life, will never go hungry and will live forever These loaves are also called the bread of the presence and remind me that I will live in your presence forever

I remember that the priests ate this bread once a week and this reminds me about my need to be in unity with others in the body of Christ. I ask you to keep me in unity as far as I am able with all men, my family, my friends and particularly those in your body.

This might be a moment to forgive someone and pray for reconciliation with them.

Keep my will ground fine like the flour that made these loaves, so that I never demand my own way above that of others

(Maybe at this point you could take communion. Some pictures of the tabernacle put a flask here as well as bread on the table and so they ate and drank together)

I come to the ALTAR OF INCENSE and remember that my worship and my prayers rise up to you as incense, I remember that you are praying through me by your Holy Spirit and I'm so grateful that you are seated at the right hand of the father interceding for me.

I praise you and worship you with all my heart and soul may this come to you as a pleasing aroma...

(maybe this is the time to intercede for anyone on our hearts and worship in tongues, thanking him for his answers)

Now I come through that beautiful VEIL that was torn from top to bottom as you died on the cross destroying the barrier between man and God.

I come through the veil of your flesh.

I come into that place of intimacy with you, and just as the high priest was only allowed to be in this area by himself, I seek to enjoy this time, just you and I sharing love together.

Thank you Lord that I come before You with no condemnation, because you have paid ALL my debt.

Thank you that because of that, I come boldly to the throne of grace without fear to find grace in time of need

Thank you Lord that the Ark of the covenant reminds me of your extraordinary faithfulness and the covenant that you Jesus made on my behalf with the father

(Then I remember what's in the ark of the covenant)

Thank you Lord that I'm free from the law because you've written your laws in my heart.

Thank you Lord that by your grace I will keep your commands

I will love you with all my mind and soul and heart, I will always keep you first place in my life and never allow an idols to replace you, I will not take your name in vain, I will keep the sabbath to keep it holy, I will honour my mother and father, I will not commit adultery or steal or lie

Perhaps this is a place to repent of anything mentioned.

Thank you, Lord, that the place of intimacy is the place of conferred

authority which I remember as I see Aaron's Rod...Thank you Lord as I see that pot of manna, I remember your supernatural provision in every area of my life

Thank you Lord that it is in the Holy Place where you speak to me and I hear your voice. Thank you, Lord, that I am enveloped in your holy presence and aware of your presence within me.

As I see the cherubim, I remember that your holy angels watch over me and protect me according to psalm 91, and guide me, and help me in every way
